



FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIPS

Conditions of Play

To be read in conjunction with RLGA Standard Conditions of Play

1. Handicap Divisions will be decided after entries close.
2. Draw to be seeded as lowest combined handicaps to highest.
3. To be played in 6's at 7 minute intervals.
4. If scores are tied after 18 holes a play-off will held over 2 holes decided by Match Committee. If still tied sudden death over same 2 holes, until winner declared. Match Committee will announce holes before hitting off.
5. Countbacks will be held in other Divisions for both scratch and handicap.
6. The Rules of Golf and Local Rules of host club shall be Rules of play. The decision of Match Committee on all points shall be final.

PROCEDURE for CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. Take entries. Arrange them in order of draw – lowest to highest. Aim for Divisions equal. Imbalance allocated to Division 1.
2. Player's responsibility to know her Golf Australia (GA) handicap and Daily Handicap according to host club's Daily Look-Up Handicap Chart prior to of play.
3. Playing pairs to calculate $\frac{1}{2}$ their combined handicaps and record on their score card prior to play.
4. At conclusion of play arrange score cards in Divisions from lowest to highest. Calculate countbacks as each card is processed.
5. ONLY check cards in contention to save time.
6. Record scores on result sheet ready for presentation.
7. RLGA President welcomes all.
8. Co-ordinator conducts presentation of trophies and prizes.
